## **1. Canadian ABBI Membership**

- Adult Membership: \$100
- Junior Membership: \$20
- Memberships may be paid at a competitor's first event or by e-transfer to [canada@americanbuckinbull.com](mailto:canada@americanbuckinbull.com).
- Eligible for Year-End Awards.
- Voting privileges for Year-End Awards and Rule Changes.
- Eligible for website cattle sale page.
- Direct email updates regarding ABBI Canada news and information.
- Discounted advertising rates on the Canadian ABBI website.

## **2. Year-End Awards**

- Only ABBI registered cattle are eligible for awards.
- Must have a Canadian ABBI Membership in good standing to qualify and vote for Year-End Awards.
- Top 4 regular season outs plus 1 Finals out = average on 5 outs.

## **3. Co-Sanctioned / CBBC Events**

- Animals must compete at a minimum of three (3) Canadian ABBI Parent Events for co-sanctioned event points to count toward Canadian ABBI Year-End Awards.
- Co-sanctioned event points may be applied toward Canadian ABBI Year-End standings once the three-event requirement has been met.
- Money won at co-sanctioned events will not count toward the BSN Most Money Award.
- Money won at co-sanctioned events will only be applied to the animal's lifetime earnings record.

## **4. BSN Most Money Award**

- Only money won at Canadian ABBI Parent Events will count toward BSN Most Money Award standings.
- For Maiden calves double-entered in the Open Yearling division, only Open Yearling earnings will count toward standings.
- Cattle must be ABBI registered.
- Must have a Canadian ABBI Membership.

## **5. Ty Pozzobon Stock Contractor of the Year**

- Must have a Canadian ABBI Membership.
- Voted on by Canadian ABBI Members in good standing.

## **6. Maiden Rules**

- Must not have been entered or scored anywhere before the Maiden event.
- Yearling bulls and yearling heifers only.
- Must be branded and numbered correctly. No exceptions.
- Cattle must be tipped.

## **7. General Rules**

- Follow the ABBI Rule Book.
- Non-registered animals may enter. Non-registered animals are not eligible for Year-End Awards.
- \$50 fee for non-registered cattle.
- Example: \$350 entry fee + \$50 non-registered fee = \$400 total entry.
- Must provide mouth age verification from a veterinarian if requested.
- Full western attire must be worn during ABBI events.
- Hartford Insurance is mandatory at each ABBI event.
